VIOLATION NOTICE

On May 18, 2023, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection of Carousel Cleaners located at 17240 East 13 Mile Road, Roseville, Michigan 48066-1619. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Carousel Cleaners compliance with the requirements of federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended; and the Air Pollution Control Rules.

Specifically, this dry cleaner is subject to the federal National Perchloroethylene Air Emission Standards for Dry Cleaning Facilities, Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 63, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Source Categories, Subpart M and the Public Health Code, Act 368 of 1978, as amended; Dry Cleaning Establishment Rules Utilizing Class I, II, III, and IV Solvents.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Commercial, Dry to Dry, Type IV Perchloroethylene dry cleaning facility	R 325.17107	Empty the containers of separator water before they overflow onto the ground.
Commercial, Dry to Dry, Type IV Perchloroethylene dry cleaning facility	R 325.17701	The exhaust fan beside the dry cleaning machine does not operate.
Commercial, Dry to Dry, Type IV Perchloroethylene dry cleaning facility	40 CFR, 63.322(m)	There are perc vapor leaks at the button trap and lint filter on dry the cleaning machine.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by June 13, 2023 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the

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violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
