DMC Sinai Grace Hospital DEQ Violation Notice

Mr. Acevedo,

This correspondence is concerning the violation notice dated September 1, 2016 and addressed to DMC Sinai Grace Hospital. The violation notice states that DMC Sinai Grace Hospital did not obtain a DEQ permit prior to installing new boilers and generators at the hospital site.

DMC Sinai Grace Hospital obtained an environmental consultant to review the DEQ requirements for the new boiler and generator systems scheduled to be installed at the hospital. The consultants completed a review of the equipment specifications and DEQ requirements prior to the equipment arriving on site. DMC Sinai Grace was assured by the consultant that all required information was obtained and the documents were submitted to the Michigan DEQ.

After discussions with my A/E firm and environmental consultants it appears that the DEQ documents were completed on August 27, 2015 but not submitted as required.

On October 4, 2016 I forwarded an email to your office and to my consultants with all required documentation concerning the new equipment and DEQ permitting process.

My consultant (Derenzo Associates) and A/E (Peter Basso Associates) will mail all required documentation to the State of Michigan DEQ ASAP and wait for their response.

All other required local and state construction permit applications were submitted for review and the permits have been received.
