On May 30, 2018 AQD staff traveled to Crawford County to perform an inspection of Sunoco Logistics Lewiston Station. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with Permit to Install No. 706-88 and applicable state and federal air pollution control regulations.

AQD staff arrived on site at 12:40 p.m. to cloudy conditions with a temperature of 81°F, and a SE wind of 13 mph. There were no noticeable odors upon arrival.

The facility shares a location with the Mark West Pipeline (SRN: B6034). Sunoco Logistics, Lewiston Station occupies the northwest quadrant of the shared area. The facility includes a Liquid Automatic Custody Transfer (LACT) unit and piping connections. The facility also includes a small storage shed and a small office shed. A previous inspection (08/17/1994) indicated that two storage tanks were located at the facility.

The small storage shed on the eastern portion of the site was locked. The small office shed just south of the storage shed looked to have been out of use for some time (noting dust and clock on wall non-functional).

The LACT unit looked to have been used recently but was not in operation during the inspection. AQD staff checked the log of loads going into the facility. The log shows recent activity for the dates of May 7, 2018 and May 9, 2018.

While at the facility AQD staff contacted Mr. Ryan Lippert who was indicated as the local supervisor of the facility. AQD staff requested a review of records and will complete when the records are received.
