Traveled to Towns Brothers Construction to confirm a void request regarding Permit to Install number 158-94C. Met with Bob Towns. PTI 158-94C permits a chrome ore crushing process and a sand drying process. The permit also covers material storage piles and yard truck traffic associated with this process. These processes have not operated in several years.

The chrome ore crushing process has been completely removed from site. This process has not operated in several years as the supply of ore was finite. The sand drying process has also not operated in several years. The rotary drum and burner is still in place but all feed both in and out has been removed. The natural gas fuel line has been cut off and MichCon has locked out the associated gas meter. As described above, there are no storage piles or yard traffic associated with these processes.

Given that the equipment has been either removed or rendered inoperable, it is recommended that this permit be voided. I explained at the meeting that if there was any interest in reinstalling the dryer, the facility would need to submit a fresh permit to install application prior to any construction.
