On November 14, 2017, I conducted a targeted scheduled inspection of Excel ElectroCircuit Inc. located at 50 Northpointe Drive, Lake Orion, MI. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the facility's compliance status with the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451; Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) rules; and Permit to Install Nos. 435-96, 1004-92, and 1003-92.

I arrived at the facility at about 2 pm. Excel ElectroCircuit is no longer occupying this building. The building was purchased in December 2016 by a company called Treva Automation. I met with Mr. Dave London. I identified myself as a MDEQ inspector, stated the purpose of the inspection, and provided him with an "Entry for Inspections" sheet.

Mr. London explained that there is not any manufacturing taking place at this facility. Treva Automation does consulting engineering and provides staffing solutions. Mr. London gave me a tour of the facility. I did not observe any equipment present in the facility that could present an air quality issue. The large warehouse attached to the office building where the printed circuit board manufacturing previously took place was completely empty. According to Mr. London the large warehouse will eventually be used for research and development in the field of robotics.

Mr. London explained that Excel ElectroCircuit has sold and scrapped all their manufacturing equipment. He stated that Excel ElectroCircuit now leases a building owned by Mr. London where they sell printed circuit boards that are manufactured overseas. It appears that Excel ElectroCircuit no longer operates any manufacturing processes at their new location.

I left the facility at 2:10 pm.

Compliance Determination

Treva Automation appears to be in compliance with the federal Clean Air Act, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451; and Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) rules.

Processes associated with permit to Install Nos. 435-96, 1004-92, and 1003-92 were removed from this location, so compliance was not verified. An email was sent to permit section to void these permits (see attached).
