On Thursday October 12, 2023, AQD Staff Michael Cox (MTC) conducted an unannounced scheduled inspection of Dixie Consumer Products, LLC (N5714) located at **400 Island Ave.**, Parchment, MI 49004. The purpose of this inspection was to verify compliance with applicable State and Federal air quality rules and regulations. MTC arrived on site at approximately 2:30 PM to conduct the inspection, however Dixie Consumer Products, LLC was no longer in operation or on site.

Facility Description:

Dixie Consumer Products, LLC historically produce food grade coated paper products. The facility was in operation with four flexographic printing presses and two machines that extrude plastic to coat printed paper.

Regulatory Overview:

Dixie Consumer Products, LLC currently has voided all their air use permits or Permits-to-Install (PTI's). The facility was subject to National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) 40 CFR 63, Subpart KK, National Emission Standards for the Printing and Publishing Industry.

Compliance Evaluation:

Upon arrival it was noted that the historic Dixie Consumer Products, LLC was no longer in operation and had totally vacated the site location. Due to the facility and permitted equipment being totally removed from the site location, no one was available for questioning that represents Dixie Consumer Products, LLC.

Compliance Determination:

Based on the on-site evaluation, Dixie Consumer Products, LLC was noted to be permanently closed and no longer in operation. Due to this fact Air Quality Division's in house data base (MACES) will be updated to reflect the changes. Overall, Dixie Consumer Products, LLC was technically found to be complying with all state and federal air pollution control regulations.
