

## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On March 15, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), received the Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) semi-annual and annual compliance certification report for Brembo North America, Inc. (Brembo). The ROP certification report states during the reporting period that all monitoring and associated recordkeeping requirements in the ROP were met and no deviations from these requirements or any other terms or conditions occurred, except for the deviations identified on the enclosed deviation report.

Based on a review of the ROP deviation report, the AQD has determined that Brembo is in violation of the following ROP conditions:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
FG-GeoMet	MI-ROP-N6226-2015, Condition I.2	ROP deviation report states that the 12-month rolling average limit for VOC (9.7 tons/year) was exceeded for July 2015 through December 2015.
FG- Magni&Black	MI-ROP-N6226-2015, Condition I.1	ROP deviation report states that the 12-month rolling average limit for VOC (9.4 tons/year) was exceeded for July 2015 through December 2015.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by May 12, 2016 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
