**VIOLATION NOTICE**

On October 24, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Great Lakes Metal Finishing located at 120 S. Dwight Street, Jackson, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Great Lakes Metal Finishing compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and Permit to Install (PTI) 153-99A.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
FGSCRUBBER	PTI 153-99A, Special Conditions FGSCRUBBER VI.2 a) & b)	Daily liquid flow of scrubber not being determined or compared to the normal operating range. Pressure drop across scrubber not being recorded on daily basis.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by November 21, 2016. The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a recurrence.

Furthermore, please include in the above written response, the Company's formal Operation and Maintenance Plan for FGSCRUBBER and FGDYE&BLACKOXIDE that meets requirements of PTI 153-99A as Staff was unable to locate the plan in the Jackson District office files.

If Great Lakes Metal Finishing believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violations cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of Great Lakes Metal Finishing.
