

On 08/29/2016, I conducted an unannounced level 2 self-initiated inspection at Crest Lincoln Mercury Sales, Inc. located at 36200 Van Dyke Ave., Sterling Heights, Michigan 48312. This facility is now known as Crest Lincoln, Inc. since Ford Motor Company discontinued the manufacture of Mercury vehicles. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451), and the administrative rules. During the inspection, I was accompanied by Mr. Bob Elliott, Service Director. At the pre-inspection conference, I showed to Mr. Elliott my ID Badge and stated the purpose of my visit.


The facility is an automobile dealership for Lincoln vehicles and the inspection was conducted on the facility's repair service shop to verify compliance with the Halogenated NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart T. Several years ago, the service shop used Halogenated degreaser solvent to clean carburetors and tools. In 1999, the AQD received communication that the facility no longer use Halogenated degreaser solvent. There were no records on file to verify compliance with the above regulation which prompted this inspection. At the facility, Mr. Elliott accompanied me for a walk through inspection and also mentioned that the facility currently uses a water base detergent cleaning solution to clean tools. He pointed to me a small equipment that appears fully enclosed as the cleaning equipment. The rest of the facility I observed to be just a mechanical repair facility for Lincoln vehicles. I requested for an SDS of the detergent cleaning solution.

Overall, I did not find any non-compliance issues during inspection.
