VIOLATION NOTICE

On April 26, 2017, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Mack Truck & Wiegand's Crushed Concrete located at 37580 Mound Road, Sterling Heights, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Mack Truck & Wiegand's Crushed Concrete's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 213-05; Consent Order AQD number 5-2006; and to investigate a recent complaint which we received on April 26, 2017, regarding fugitive dust attributed to Mack Truck & Wiegand's Crushed Concrete's operations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plant	R 336.1901 Permit # 213-05, General condition No. 6 Consent Order # 213-05, paragraphs 10.	The particulate fallout has resulted in an unreasonable interference with the comfortable enjoyment of life and property.

In the professional judgment of AQD staff, the particulate fallout event that was observed during the inspection was of sufficient intensity so as to constitute a violation of Rule 901 and General Condition number 6 of PTI number 213-05. This determination is supported by laboratory analyses received by the AQD on May 30, 2017, which correlate the appearance and properties of particulates collected at Wiegand's and the complainant's location.

The cited General Condition number 6 of PTI number 213-05 is also enforceable as paragraph 10 of Consent Order, AQD number 5-2006.

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Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by July 21, 2017 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a recurrence.

If Mack Truck & Wiegand's Crushed Concrete believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violation cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of April 26, 2017.
