VIOLATION NOTICE

On June 25, 2015, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Bond Crushed Concrete located at 3740 Patterson Road, Bay City, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 338-08.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
Conveyor 12	Rule 336.1201	The conveyor was installed and operated without a permit.
EU process	Special Condition III 1	The fugitive dust plan was not being followed.
EU process	Special Condition VI 1	There were not any records of amount of material processed.

It should be noted the fugitive dust plan required to be implemented and maintained by Special Condition III 1 was being disregarded. The plan refers to a paved main entrance. There was no evidence of pavement existing. If it was there, it was covered by a thick layer of dust. There was no evidence of any calcium chloride application. Water apparently had not been used either. The fugitive dust plan also contains recordkeeping provisions but there were no records whatsoever.

It is recognized that a permit application to address the installation of the conveyor has finally been received by AQD. Please initiate actions necessary to correct the other cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by August 26,

2015, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Bond Crushed Concrete believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violations cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection.
