**SECOND VIOLATION NOTICE**

On June 25, 2015, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Bond Crushed Concrete, located at 3740 Patterson Road, Bay, Michigan. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; and Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 338-08.

On August 5, 2015, the AQD sent the company a Violation Notice citing violations discovered as a result of the inspection and requested your written response by August 26, 2015. A copy of that letter is enclosed for your reference. As of this date, we have not received your response.

Please be advised that failure to respond in writing and identifying actions the company will take or has taken to resolve the cited violations may result in escalated enforcement action by the AQD. Please provide the information requested in our August 5, 2015 letter by September 14, 2015, which corresponds to 14 days from the date of this letter.

Be further advised that issuance of this Violation Notice does not preclude or limit the DEQ's ability to initiate any other enforcement action under state or federal law as appropriate.
