As per our discussion yesterday, here is the action plan for achieving compliance at Cosma Casting Michigan in Battle Creek.

- 1) A permit modification will be submitted by 18 February 2015 in order to accomplish the following items.
 - a. Allow for heat treating of oil-coated parts
 - b. Include the actual size of the generator currently onsite
 - c. We will also investigate whether any proposed changes in the next 12-18 months would require a permit modification and include those as necessary.
- 2) The stacks will be brought into compliance with the permit requirements. We anticipate this work will be completed within the next 3 months.
