On Monday, June 18, 2012, the AQD received requested information regarding the heat input rating of the oil heaters used in the roasting room. The oil heaters are rated at 1,700,000 Btu per hour and are fired only with sweet natural gas. The Btu heat input value appears to indicate that the roasting process is exempt from the requirements of R 336.1201 per R 336.1282(a)(v) because the oil heaters are rated less than 10,000,000 Btu per hour and because the product is either coated with a sweet substance or mixed with sweet items for human consumption.
