**VIOLATION NOTICE**

On October 20, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), received emissions test data for Plasan Carbon Composites located at 3195 Wilson Drive NW, Walker, Michigan. The report and test data were used to determine Plasan Carbon Composites' compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 130-12C.

Based on a review of the test data, staff verified the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
Regenerative Thermal Oxidizer on EU-PAINTLINE-1	PTI No. 130-12C, FGPAINT, Special Condition IV.3.	Testing conducted on September 27, 2016 resulted in a destruction efficiency of 91.8%, which is below the 95% limit in the permit.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by November 23, 2016. The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Plasan Carbon Composites believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
