On May 16, 2024, I (Owen Pierce EGLE - Air Quality Division) performed a scheduled targeted inspection of Power Solutions International located at 32505 Industrial Drive, Madison Heights, Michigan. Jillian Cellini (EGLE-AQD) joined me on the inspection. In a letter from the Air Quality Division Permit Section, dated February 16, 2021, it was explained that permit No.76-13A, for three engine dynamometer test cells, has been voided per the request of the facility. The letter further explains that the permit is void because the facility has shut down and equipment has been removed. As a result, the purpose of the inspection was to confirm that the facility was no longer operating and the permitted process and control equipment described in Permit to Install (PTI) No.76-13A were no longer in use. Upon arrival, I observed the facility was now called Motor City Supplies. Jillian and I entered into the facility and spoke with Jim who is the warehouse manager. After meeting Jim, I stated the purpose of the inspection and asked for a tour of the facility.

During the facility walk-through, Jim explained that Motor City Supplies has occupied the facility at 32505 Industrial Drive for approximately one to two years. Jim explained that Motor City Supplies provides food industry supplies to its customers such as: food packaging, paper products, napkin sleeves, etc. I observed that the facility is used as a warehouse, and I did not observe any of the process and control equipment described in PTI No.76-13A. In addition, there were no boilers, generators, nor cold cleaners observed at the facility, and I did not see any other equipment subject to air quality regulations during the inspection.

As a result of my inspection, I can confirm that Power Solutions International is permanently closed and no longer emits or has the potential to emit air contaminants, and the equipment included in the voided PTI No.76-13A has been removed.
