


Violation Notice February 13, 2018

Dear Mr. Dickman,

We are in receipt of your February 13, 2018 Violation Notice. You noted that Engine 1 at the facility had been changed out with a similar engine, but that Core Energy did not provide the required notified notification as required in our Permit to Install Number 82-13, Special Condition number VII.1 as stated below.

Except as provided in R 336.1285, if the engine is replaced with an equivalent-emitting or lower-emitting engine, the permittee shall notify the AQD District Supervisor of such change-out and submit acceptable emissions data to show that the alternate engine is equivalent-emitting or lower-emitting. The data shall be submitted within 30-days of the engine change out.

Per your request, enclosed is Gas Technical Data recently provided by Caterpillar for the engine that was replaced on July 25, 2015. This technical sheet is the best available information as updated by Caterpillar. The replacement engine was a similar type 3516 LE with catalytic control.

In the future, Core Energy will notify the AQD District Supervisor in a timely manner should there be any future engine swaps, and provide all necessary data to comply with our permit to install requirements. Thank you for your understanding on this matter.
