
On Friday, March 20, 2020, Air Quality Division inspector Scott Evans (SE), accompanied by Wade O'Boyle (WO) and John Vrugink (JV) of the Materials Management Division, conducted a scheduled inspection of the KroPro facility located in Muskegon Michigan. Upon arrival, SE, WO, and JV were greeted by KroPro Operator Jake Krol (JK) and building owner Bill Cooper (BC).

KroPro is a small, chrome plating business that handles small scale orders. The business has not operated in many months. During the inspection it was observed that all process equipment has been removed from the facility, rendering it inoperable. The remaining items in the building are barrels of excess waste materials that are to be removed. It was expressed by JK and BC that there is currently no intent to re-open the facility as a chrome plating operation. It is recommended that the Permit to Install No. 144-18 be voided.

The facility has been contacted to confirm their wish to void the permit. Once they have confirmed their intent to cease all operations and remain closed, the permit will be voided.
