On October 17, 2024, staff Chris Robinson (CR) and Alicia Kusaka (AK) from Michigan's Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) Air Quality Division (AQD) attempted to conduct an inspection at ASP Plating Company located at 211 North Griffin Street in Grand Haven Michigan. The purpose of the inspection was to determine this facility's compliance with applicable state and federal air quality rules and regulations.

Upon arrival it was obvious that the facility was not operating. A portion of the parking lot had been closed off, and no cars were there. AQD staff knocked on the entrance to the building which there was no response to. CR has observed over the last year or two that the building appeared vacant. Per a Holland Sentinel article, the facility had violated the Clean Waters Act for discharging zinc unlawfully. EPA enforcement appears to have occurred around the time that CR noticed the building no longer being used. Based on observations, CR does not believe this facility is operating. Therefore, Maces operating status has been changed to "Permanently closed". The facility had been operating under Rule 201 permitting exemptions only.
