Pro-Tech Environmental, Inc. performed asbestos abatement, full structure demolition, and now nonmetallic mineral crushing at 701 Ann Street in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

Pro-Tech Environmental, Inc. has rented a 2022 Sandvik mobile crusher from Alta Equipment along with a 2022 Ecoverse BT-842 stacker for the crushing operations at the address above. The violation date was November 14th, when April Lazzaro was on site and called Pro-Tech Environmental, Inc. office for questions about the project around 11:34am.

Adam Snyder quickly returned April phone call at 11:36 am for the initial discussion about the violation and project. During the discussion, Pro-Tech/Adam was unaware of having to file for permit for leased equipment as this was the first project of self-performed material crushing. April Lazzaro thoroughly explained the process for permitting and what is required for the future. Pro-Tech immediately stopped all crushing, filed for permit on November 16th, and waited for approval of crushing permit.

In the future as Pro-Tech plans to perform additional material crushing, Pro-Tech will engage in discussion to ensure all policies and procedures are followed prior to the start of project. As Pro-Tech did multiple times with Mr. Jeremy Brown, EGLE, on this project prior to commencement, they will engage April Lazzaro in discussions to ensure compliance prior to any work has commenced.
