VIOLATION NOTICE

On June 4, 2024, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted a site visit of Neogen Corporation located at 720 East Shiawassee Street, Lansing, Michigan. The purpose of this visit was to determine Neogen Corporation's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); and the Air Pollution Control Rules.

During the site visit, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
Construction of an unpermitted manufacturing facility.	R 336.1201 (Rule 201)	The AQD staff witnessed construction at 720 East Shiawassee Street. Commencement of Construction of an unpermitted process is a violation of Rule 201.

During this site visit, it was noted that Neogen Corporation had commenced construction of a manufacturing facility subject to Rule 201 without obtaining an air use permit to install. This is a violation of Rule 201 of the administrative rules promulgated under Act 451. Be advised that Rule 201 requires that a permit be obtained prior to installation, construction, operation, reconstruction, relocation, or alteration of any process or process equipment which may be a source of an air contaminant.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by July 5, 2024, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter).

The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred (including the dates that construction of the building located at 720 East Shiawassee began and planned completion dates); an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Neogen Corporation believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
