SECOND VIOLATION NOTICE

On January 3, 2019, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD) performed an asbestos inspection at 8981 Red Arrow Highway, Bridgman, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

On January 14, 2019, the AQD sent Hollerbach Excavating (Company) a Violation Notice (VN) citing violations discovered because of the inspection and requested the Company's written response by February 4, 2019. A copy of this VN has been enclosed for your reference. As of the date of this letter, the AQD has not received the Company's written response to the cited violation.

Please be advised that failure to respond in writing and identifying actions the Company will take or has taken to resolve the cited violation may result in an escalated enforcement action by the AQD. Please provide the information requested in the VN dated January 14, 2019 by February 20, 2019, which corresponds to 14 days from the date of this letter.

The Company's written response must be submitted to Mr. Craig Dechy at DEQ, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760, and must include a copy to Ms. Jenine Camilleri, Enforcement Unit Supervisor at the DEQ, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing,



VIOLATION NOTICE

On January 3, 2019, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) complaint investigation at 8981 Red Arrow Highway, Bridgman, Berrien County. The purpose of this investigation was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, Siemans Ford, Inc., owns the subject facility and Hollerbach Excavating performed the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Demolition activities had taken place at the former commercial facility and the site had been back-filled and graded. The owner or operator did not have a thorough asbestos inspection performed prior to the demolition activities and no Notification of Intent to Renovate/Demolish had been submitted to the administrator.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this violation notice by February 4, 2019 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If you believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute a violation of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
