VIOLATION NOTICE

Morrish Road, Swartz Creek, Genesee County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended. and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), On February 22, 2022, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted a complaint investigation at 5200 South

RBF Construction, Inc., was the operator performing the demolition activities. The According to my investigation, Diesel Pro's, LLC, owns the facility being demolished and liable for all violations. National Emission Standard for Asbestos (NESHAP) holds the *owner and operator*

During the inspection, EGLE staff observed the following:

The former commercial garage was demolished, and RBF Construction, Inc., was on-site breaking up the remaining concrete slab. No Notification of Intent to Renovate/Demolish was provided to the administrator prior to the demolition activities.
