## VIOLATION NOTICE

On August 13, 2024, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection at the commercial properties located at 1140 South Lapeer Road; and 1112-1128 South Lapeer Road, Lake Orion, Oakland County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, EROP, LLC owns the property, and Next Generation Construction 2, LLC, conducted the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for violations.

During the inspection, AQD staff noted two commercial buildings, on adjacent properties, being demolished. A notification of intent had not been filed for these demolitions. Documentation verifying asbestos survey and abatement activities at the site was provided.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by September 20, 2024. The response should include:

- An explanation of the causes and duration of the violation;

- Whether the violation is ongoing;
- A summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place;
- What steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence; and
- Acknowledgement of receipt, and understanding of, the attached "Understanding NESHAP" fact sheet.

The signed written response from the owner and operator to this violation notice may be submitted by mail and directed to the attention of Jeremy Howe, Supervisor, Technical Programs Unit, at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760 and must include a copy to Jason Wolf, Enforcement Unit at the same address. If the listed parties believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
