On September 14th, 2018 one of your analysts performed an inspection of our site at 6078 Hackett Rd. Freeland, MI.

During this inspection, it was discovered that we were not in compliance with the requirements of the Clean Air Act by operating unpermitted equipment.

In the time since the inspection, we have installed a breathable tarp across the open wall on the South side of the blasting building. We have also ordered one for the opening on the West side of the building. This tarp will be installed upon delivery. These tarps allow fresh air to enter the building but do not allow dust to escape. At this time, we are looking at some different dust control systems to be installed in this building within the next year.

Since the inspection, our exhaust fans in our paint shop are having dry-filters installed. We are also looking at some ventilation options to be installed in this building within the next year. We are keeping records of our coatings use as well.
