Dear Interested Party:

You are receiving this letter because you have indicated an interest in actions associated with FCA US LLC (FCA). This letter is to update you on two Permit to Install (PTI) applications for FCA. PTI Application No. 14-19A is for the proposed modification of a permitted automobile assembly line under construction at the Detroit Assembly Complex Mack Plant (Mack), which is located at 4000 Saint Jean Street, Detroit Michigan. PTI No. 33-20 is for the proposed installation of a new tutone coating line and changes to existing equipment at the Jefferson North Assembly Plant (JNAP), which is located at 2101 Conner Street, Detroit, Michigan.

The law requires the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) to allow the public to comment on some actions, such as the applications for FCA. Public comments are a very important part of making sure the application has been thoroughly reviewed.


