This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install (PTI) application, identified as No. 33-20, for a proposed automotive coating line, relocation of the rapid reprocess operations, and various refurbishments to existing equipment at the Jefferson North Assembly Plant located at 2101 Conner Avenue, Detroit, Michigan (State Registration Number N2155).

Two public comment periods were held for this application. A public hearing was held on September 9, 2020, and the first public comment period ended on September 18, 2020. A second public hearing was held on March 16, 2021, and the second public comment period ended on March 22, 2021. Comments were received during both comment periods and at both public hearings.

After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), I have approved PTI No. 33-20. As a part of this approval, Air Quality Division (AQD) staff has revised and added conditions to the permit to address certain information received during the public participation process and the subsequent analysis of that information.

The AQD has prepared the enclosed Response to Comments (RTC) Document, which provides our responses to comments received during the public comment period and at the public hearing. It also identifies the special conditions that have been modified and provides our rationale for modifying the proposed special conditions. These changes are listed in Section II of the RTC Document.

This approval is based upon and subject to compliance with all administrative rules of EGLE and conditions stipulated in the enclosed supplement. Please review these conditions thoroughly so that you may take the actions necessary to ensure compliance with all of these conditions.

The equipment covered by this permit is also subject to the requirements of the Renewable Operating Permit Program. Submittal of the M-001 and C-001 forms may be required prior to commencing operation. A change that is subject to Rule 215 subrules (1), (2), or (3), promulgated pursuant to Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the

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Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, requires the submittal of the forms to the appropriate AQD District Office. If a change is made pursuant to Rule 216, please submit the required forms to the Cadillac District Office at the address provided in the M-001 form instructions. Also, you must notify the Detroit District Office, in writing, within 30 days after completion of the installation, construction, reconstruction, relocation, or modification of the process or process equipment covered by this PTI.
