Dear Interested Party:

Thank you for your interest in the Permit to Install (PTI) application submitted by FCA US LLC (FCA), to the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). The application is requesting the installation of a new coating operation, relocation of a repair operation, and various refurbishments to existing equipment at the Jefferson North Assembly Plant (JNAP), which is located at 2101 Conner Avenue, Detroit, Michigan.

Pursuant to state and federal requirements, EGLE held a public comment period on its proposed conditional approval of the permit that ended on September 18, 2020, including a virtual public hearing held on September 9, 2020. The Air Quality Division (AQD) received six written comments during the first public comment period, four verbal comments were presented at the public hearing, and three verbal comments were received via voicemail during the first public comment period.

After changes to the proposed project and updates to the proposed permit, EGLE held a second public comment period on its proposed conditional approval of the permit that ended on March 22, 2021, including a virtual public hearing held on March 16, 2021. The AQD received seven written comments during the second public comment period and eleven verbal comments were presented at the second public hearing.

After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of EGLE, I have approved PTI No. 33-20 with modifications made to the proposed permit.

The Response to Comments (RTC) Document provides our responses to comments received during the public comment periods and at the public hearings. It also identifies special conditions which have been modified and provides our rationale for modifying the proposed special conditions. The changes are listed in Section II of the RTC Document. Changes made to the permit include:

- FG-FACILITY Special Conditions I.1, I.2, I.3, and I.4
 - Underlying Applicable Requirement (UAR) R 336.2810 was added
 - UAR 40 CFR 52.21 was changed to 40 CFR 52.21(j)
- Appendix 9
 - The following sentence was added to the first paragraph to clarify the corresponding recordkeeping and reporting requirements for volatile organic compounds and oxides of nitrogen because Reasonable Possibility has been triggered under the State of Michigan Part 19 rules.

“The monitoring, recordkeeping, and reporting requirements for the pollutants listed below are listed in FG-FACILITY, SC VI.5 and SC VII.3.”


