Dear Interested Party:

We are sending you this information because you may have an interest in air quality related activities associated with Marathon Petroleum Company LP (Marathon). The company has submitted an air permit application (No. APP-2022-0004) for the proposed optimization of sulfur production at the two sulfur recovery units at Marathon’s Detroit Refinery. The refinery is located at 1001 South Oakwood Boulevard in Detroit, Michigan.

The law requires the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) to open some actions for the public to comment on, such as what Marathon is requesting. Public comments are a very important part of making sure the application has been thoroughly reviewed.

Information about the air permit application, such as a summary of the proposed project, the proposed permit conditions, and the fact sheet containing the regulatory analysis of the proposed permit conditions are available to review. At the public hearing

On **August 1, 2022**, a virtual informational session and public hearing will be held. In addition, a viewing of the virtual hearing will be held at the Kemeny Recreation Center, located at 2260 South Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan 48217. At the viewing attendees will be given the opportunity to ask questions of the virtual panel and provide comment on the record. EGLE staff will be present to assist.

The virtual meeting and in-person viewing will begin at 6:00 pm, with a brief presentation about the proposed project and the draft air permit and will include an opportunity for the public to ask questions of EGLE staff. The public hearing will be immediately following to take official comments on the record.

The AQD will review and consider all comments received during the comment period before making the final decision, and a written response and a copy of the decision made about the proposed permit will be provided to you.
