Dear Interested Party:

Thank you for your interest regarding the Permit to Install (PTI) Application No. APP-2022-0125 submitted by FCA US LLC Detroit Assembly Complex – Mack (FCA Mack), to the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), requesting changes to an existing automotive manufacturing process, for the facility located at 4000 St. Jean Street in Detroit, Michigan.

Pursuant to state and federal requirements, EGLE held a public comment period that ended with a hybrid public hearing on September 5, 2024, on its proposed conditional approval of the permit. The Air Quality Division (AQD) received 52 sets of written and voicemail comments during the public comment period and 12 sets of verbal comments were presented at the public hearing.

After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of EGLE, I have approved PTI No. 14-19B with modifications made to the proposed permit.

The Response to Comments (RTC) Document provides our responses to comments received during the public comment period and at the public hearing. It also identifies special conditions which have been modified and provides our rationale for modifying the proposed special conditions. The changes are listed in Section II of the RTC Document. Changes made to the permit include:

1. References to test method regulations were corrected.
2. Obsolete footnotes and stack references were removed.
