Dear Interested Party:

We are sending you this information because you may have an interest in air quality related activities associated with Edw. C. Levy Co. The company has submitted an air permit application (No. APP-2023-0070) for the proposed installation and operation of a new blast furnace slag grinding plant proposed to be located at 8941 West Jefferson Avenue, in Detroit, Michigan.

The law requires the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) to open some actions for the public to comment on, such as what Edw. C. Levy Co. is requesting. Public comments are a very important part of making sure the application has been thoroughly reviewed.

Information about the air permit application, such as the summary of the proposed project, the proposed permit conditions, and the fact sheet containing the regulatory analysis of the proposed permit conditions are available to review. 
