Graphic Packaging International, LLC, Kalamazoo County, Michigan – (SRN B1678)

EGLE is holding a public comment period on a Consent Order and air permit from **August 31**, to **October 16, 2023**, and a virtual public hearing on **October 5**.

- The proposed Consent Order addressed emission limits and equipment installation violations.
- The Company is requesting changes to its existing air permit (PTI No. 133-19A) for a paperboard machine project including adding a continuous emission monitoring system (CEMS) to several boilers; modifying the allowed oxides of nitrogen (NO_x) emission limits, removing old equipment, and correcting the capacity of fuel burning equipment.
