Dear Mr Korniski:

BASF Corporation requests the following Rule 216 administrative change to its Chemical Plants ROP (MI-ROP-B4359-2003b) found in the attached M-001 form. This change is required due to the installation of an additional beltline and associated equipment at its Thermoplastic Polyurethanes Plant (TPU) covered by section 3 of the above ROP. Specifically, the change requires the addition of a second "synthesis" emission unit at TPU, replacing EUTPUSYNTHESIS with EUTPUSYNTHESIS1 and EUTPUSYNTHESIS2. This equipment was installed under several PTI exemptions - Rule 290 and Rule 286(a) and subject to the operating requirements already found in the permit under FGTPURULE290. The equipment will become operational the week of November 1st, 2010.
