## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On September 16, 2020, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), received the semi-annual deviation report from Dow Silicones Operating Permit MI-ROP-A4043-2019. Corporation located at 3901 South Saginaw Road, Midland, Michigan for Renewable

Operating Permit (ROP) number MI-ROP-A4043-2019 for EU207-03: During review of the deviation report, staff observed the following deviations of Renewable

Be advised that Rule 201 requires that a permit be obtained prior to installation, construction, operation, reconstruction, relocation, or alteration of any process or process equipment which may be a source of an air contaminant.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by December 14, 2020 (which includes the extension requested). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

Please submit the written response to EGLE, AQD, Bay City District, at 401 Ketchum Street, Suite B, Bay City, Michigan 48708 and submit a copy to Ms. Jenine Camilleri, Enforcement Unit Supervisor at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760.

If Dow Silicones Corporation believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
