I (Sydney Bruestle) visited Huron Inc. on May 25, 2016 to perform an onsite inspection. The purpose of this inspection was to verify compliance with Permit to Install (PTI) 34-90 and PTI 33-90. Huron Inc. only holds two active permits with the State of Michigan.

Huron Inc. is located at 6554 Lakeshore Rd in Lexington, MI. The facility makes small automotive parts and currently employs 440 people. While on site I met with Kevin Pedler, the Environmental Health and Safety Manager. He walked me through the facility and showed me all currently permitted emission units as well as exempt and unpermitted units.

There are several braze furnaces on site and atmosphere generators. The furnaces vent outside the plant but are exempt from permitting under rule 285 (i).

PTI 33-90 is for two ewald spot welders, these units are no longer in use and are also exempt under rule 285 (i). Mr. Pedler has sent in a request to void PTI 33-90.

PTI 34-90 is for a cold parts cleaner. This unit is still in use, however is exempt under rule 285 (r)(iv) because emissions are released in plant and the annual VOC emissions are 1- 3 tpy, which is well below the rule threshold of 40 tons VOC per year. Mr. Pedler maintains emission records for the cold parts cleaner. He has also sent in a request to void PTI 34-90.

Once PTI 33-90 and PTI 34-90 are voided, the facility will no longer have any active PTI's with the state of Michigan. They will also no longer need to report To MAERS.

While on site it appeared Huron Inc. is in compliance with all applicable state and federal air quality regulations.
