VIOLATION NOTICE

On September 4, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), investigated the intensity of black smoke observed emanating from the cracking plant flare at Marathon Petroleum Company LP (Marathon) located at 1300 S. Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan. The purpose of the investigation was to determine Marathon's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules; and the conditions of Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) number MI-ROP-A9831-2012b.

Mr. Jonathan Lamb of the AQD conducted Method 9 visible emissions readings. As a result, the following air pollution violation was observed:

Enclosed is a copy of the instantaneous and six-minute average readings taken at Marathon Petroleum Company LP.


Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 6, 2014 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
