VIOLATION NOTICE

On January 14, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection of Kent Foundry Co. located at 1413 Callaghan Street, Greenville, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Kent Foundry Co.'s compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules; the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 704-91B; and the requirements of 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart ZZZZZ (National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Iron and Steel Foundries Area Sources).

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

If Kent Foundry Co. believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
