**RE: September 12, 2019 Violation Notice Concerning Alleged
Nuisance Odors Detected September 7, 2019**

Dear Mr. Lamb,

Solutia, Inc. ("Solutia") received your September 12, 2019, Violation Notice alleging that from approximately 8:45 AM to 10:30 AM on September 7, 2019, you detected nuisance odors that you believed were coming from Solutia's Trenton, Michigan facility (the Site). It is our understanding that you personally detected odors up to 1.7 miles away from the site.

Thank you for bringing this matter to our attention. Solutia is committed to be a good neighbor and notice of such possible offsite impacts is important to meeting that objective.

Upon receipt of your phone call around 9:30 AM on September 7th, we immediately completed a physical walkdown of the site. Our review of site activities during these times did not reveal any unusual actions or operating conditions in the plant. All air pollution control equipment parameters (e.g., condensers coolant flowrate and temperature, scrubbers water flowrate, etc.) were monitored and the recorded data indicates Solutia's operations were in compliance with air emission permit requirements. No abnormal odors were reported by Solutia personnel on duty at the time of the alleged offsite odors.

Thank you for bringing this issue to our attention. Solutia takes being a good neighbor seriously and wishes to avoid being the source of offsite odors. As you did on the morning of September 7th, please notify a site-wide supervisor via telephone at 734-672-7903 at any time you become aware of any alleged offsite odors that you believe are coming from the Site. This will allow us the opportunity to evaluate our site operations at that time and better determine if we are the source,

the cause and how to prevent recurrence.

Thank you again for your bringing this matter to our attention. We very much appreciate your notice.
