Dear Mr. Lamb:

This letter is in response to the Violation Notice (“NOV”) dated November 29, 2017, issued to the United States Gypsum Company (“USG”), located at 10090 West Jefferson Avenue, River Rouge, Michigan. The NOV cites alleged violations involving failure to perform Initial Performance testing for visible emissions according to New Source Performance Standard (NSPS) Subpart OOO performance testing requirements.

USG will address the NOV by conducting performance testing on the building that houses: EU-9 Granular System, EU-23 Raymond Mill, and EU-35 HRA landplaster bin on January 4<sup>th</sup> 2018 to satisfy the Initial testing requirement. Testing will be completed by Montrose Air Quality Services Division according to the emissions test plan letter that was submitted to the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality on November 30, 2017.

USG will continue to perform weekly visible emissions checks utilizing US EPA Method 22 on the emission sources after the initial performance test. If you have any questions or require additional information, please contact Brian Geter, Environmental Coordinator, at (313) 624-4231.
