**VIOLATION NOTICE**

On March 15, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), received the Renewable Operating Permit Deviation Report for General Motors LLC-Pontiac North Campus (General Motors), located at 1 Pontiac Plaza, Pontiac, Michigan. During the review of the report, staff of the AQD observed the following:

ROP No. MI-ROP-B4032-2014b, Table FG-TESTCELLMACT, Condition III. 1	During December 1 through December 9, the thermal oxidizer temperatures of RTO #4 were kept below the newly set-point levels established during the destruction efficiency (DE) test of October 2015.

Although in the report General Motors has indicated the cause of the violation and actions necessary to correct the cited violation, please submit a written response to this Violation Notice by July 6, 2016 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: a summary of the actions that have been taken to correct the violation and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If General Motors believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
