VIOLATION NOTICE

On September 4, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), received notice that the stack heights for EUCONTNRNOCTRL were outside permitted limits. This is a violation of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules and the conditions of Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) number MI-ROP-B4197-2011. The violation is as follows:

EUCONTNRNOCTRL	MI-ROP-B4197-2011, EUCONTRNOCTRL, SC VIII.1 SVBOOTHSTACK SC VIII.2 SVOVENSTACK	Maximum permitted exhaust diameter of SVBOOTHSTACK is 24 inches. Maximum permitted exhaust diameter of SVOVENSTACK is 8 inches. Minimum permitted height above ground is 60 feet for both stacks.

The records provided to the DEQ on September 4, 2014 indicate that the actual exhaust diameter of SVBOOTHSTACK is 26 inches, and the actual height of the stack is 52 feet above ground. The actual exhaust diameter of SVOVENSTACK is 8 inches and the stack height is 52 feet above ground.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 7, 2014 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct

the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If AAR Mobility Systems believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
