Dear Mr. Lamb:

This letter is in response to the violation notice we received dated November 7, 2017. The following is our response.

The Violation Notice stated that the facility failed to perform burner tune-ups and CO monitoring prior to the start of the 2016 and 2017 paving season. Cadillac Asphalt has been using the services of Combustion Services Inc. to conduct the burner tuning and CO readings at several of our facilities. Due to the recent addition of several plants in the last couple of years, Cadillac recognizes that our consultant was and will be unable to fulfill this task for our plants. Several attempts were made to complete the CO readings and burner tuning in May; however the plant was not operating long enough for this to occur. Therefore we have purchased three ECOM-D combustion analyzers. The analyzers were purchased in September. Training has been completed at all our plants and results have been recorded.

Cadillac will also be utilizing our environmental support staff to track each plants recorded CO readings. Since these analyzers have email capabilities, each time CO readings are performed, emails are being sent to our support staff.

Cadillac Asphalt believes that the above actions will allow us to maintain compliance. Should you have any questions or require additional information, please feel free to contact me at 734-777-3647.
