VIOLATION NOTICE

On December 17, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Light Metals Corporation located at 2740 Prairie Street SW, Grandville, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Light Metals Corporation's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); and the administrative rules.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Anodize Line	Rule 201	Failure to obtain Permit to Install

During this inspection, it was noted that Light Metals Corporation had installed and commenced operation of an unpermitted process at this facility. The AQD staff advised Kevin Kane on January 6, 2015, that this is a violation of Act 451, Rule 201. AQD has also requested that Light Metals Corporation conduct an updated facility Potential to Emit demonstration.

A program for compliance may include a completed PTI application for the anodize line process equipment. An application form is available by request, or at the following website:

Be advised that Rule 201 requires that a permit be obtained prior to installation, construction, operation, reconstruction, relocation, or alteration of any process or process equipment which may be a source of an air contaminant.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by January 29, 2015. The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
