## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On September 17, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Romeo RIM, Inc. located at 74000 Van Dyke Avenue, Romeo, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Romeo RIM's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules, the conditions of Permits to Install (PTI) number 365-8B and 144-10 and the conditions of Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) number MI-ROP-B5854-2009.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

FGSHUTTLECLAMP	PTI No. 144-10, SC II.1	The records show that during August 2012 through July 2014, the facility used coating with VOC content that exceeded the VOC content limit specified in the PTI.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 17, 2014. The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Romeo RIM, Inc. believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violations cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of September 17, 2014.
