

VIOLATION NOTICE

On January 9, 2017, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Oliver Products located at 445 Sixth Street NW, Grand Rapids, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Oliver Products' compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); and the Air Pollution Control Rules.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Ten Coating Lines	Rule 201	Failure to obtain permit to install

During this inspection, it was noted that Oliver Products had commenced operation of unpermitted processes at this facility. The AQD staff advised Oliver Products on January 9, 2017, that this is a violation of Act 451, Rule 201.

A program for compliance may include a completed PTI application for the Coating Lines. An application form is available by request, or at the following website:

Be advised that Rule 201 requires that a permit be obtained prior to installation, construction, operation, reconstruction, relocation, or alteration of any process or process equipment which may be a source of an air contaminant.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by February 16, 2017 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

In addition, please provide a facility-wide Potential to Emit (PTE) demonstration for all pollutants at the source within 30 days of this letter. Information on calculating PTE can be found at the following website:

If Oliver Products believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
