VIOLATION NOTICE

On September 14, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Eagle Alloy, Inc., located at 5142 Evanston Avenue, Muskegon, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Eagle Alloy's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 95-01F; and the requirements of 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart ZZZZZ (National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Iron and Steel Foundries Area Sources).

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
Sand Coating Plant	Permit to Install No. 95-01F, Special Condition V.2.	Failure to conduct testing to verify the VOC emission rate within two years of the initial test.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 21, 2016 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Eagle Alloy believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
