VIOLATION NOTICE

On June 10, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Huntington Cleaners, 8775 Capital Street, Oak Park, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Huntington Cleaners' compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act and Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

Specifically, this dry cleaner is subject to the Dry Cleaning Establishment Rules Utilizing Class I, II, III, and IV Solvents.

During the inspection, staff of the DEQ, AQD, observed the following:

Commercial, Dry to Dry, Type IIIA Hydrocarbon dry cleaning facility	R 325.17202(a)	The dry cleaning establishment was modified without notification, plans, or approval (installed a hydrocarbon dry cleaning machine).


Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by July 14, 2016 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Huntington Cleaners believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
