SECOND VIOLATION NOTICE

On January 10, 2018, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Super White Laundry & Dry Cleaners located at 1306 Ford Avenue Wyandotte, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Super White Laundry & Dry Cleaners compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act and Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

Specifically, this dry cleaner is subject to the federal National Perchloroethylene Air Emission Standards for Dry Cleaning Facilities, Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 63, Subpart M and the Public Health Code, 1978 PA 368, as amended, Dry Cleaning Establishment Rules Utilizing Class I, II, III, and IV Solvents.

On January 12, 2018, the AQD sent the company a Violation Notice citing violation discovered as a result of the inspection and requested your written response by February 1, 2018. A copy of that letter is enclosed for your reference. As of this date, we have not received your response.

Please be advised that failure to respond in written and identifying actions the company will take or has taken to resolve the cited violations may result in escalated enforcement actions by the AQD. Please provide the information requested in our January 12, 2018 letter by March 9, 2018, which corresponds to 14 days from the date of this letter.

Be further advised that issuance of this Violations Notice does not preclude or limit the DEQ's ability to initiate any other enforcement action under state or federal law as appropriate.
