On 1/21/2015, I conducted an annual inspection at Pontiac School District. The inspection was required because AQD files indicate there were some incinerators located in the District. I need to verify those incinerators' status. Around 9:50 AM, I went to the school District Maintenance Building, located on the SE corner of Sagnaw St. & Montcalm Rd. in Pontiac. I met with Mr. Bill Gibbons & explained the purpose of the inspection. Bill told me that Mr. Rob Englund would contact me regarding to the incinerators. On 1/27/2015, I talked to Mr. Englund over the phone. He told me that they had not operated any incinerator since he worked there five years ago. I told him that he needed to verify all the incinerators in the district; i.e. whether the pieces of equipment were removed, or stored somewhere. If they were on-site, I needed to know the operational status of the incinerators. On Feb. 9, Mr. Englund wrote to me that all the incinerators had been removed from the School District. As a result, there won't be any air quality concerns in regards to the incinerators.
