VIOLATION NOTICE

On September 14, 2015, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted a complaint investigation at and in the vicinity of State Crushing-East, Inc. located at 25501 Sherwood Avenue, Warren, Michigan. The purpose of this investigation was to investigate a complaint regarding fugitive dust created from trackout attributed to State Crushing-East's operations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
Fugitive Dust Production from trackout from State Crushing-East, Inc.	Rule 901	It was determined fugitive dust created from trackout from State Crushing, Inc. was creating an unreasonable interference with the enjoyment of life and property in the vicinity of the company's operations.

During this inspection, AQD staff observed an excessive amount of trackout from State Crushing-East's property onto Sherwood Avenue in Warren. A significant amount of fugitive dust was observed to have been created from vehicle traffic along Sherwood Avenue at the time of AQD staff's investigation. The amount of dust produced from trackout created an unreasonable interference with the enjoyment of life and property in the vicinity of State Crushing-East in the opinion of AQD staff.


Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 6, 2015 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the

violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If State Crushing-East believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute a violation of the applicable legal requirement cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violation cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of State Crushing-East.
